Check-In Process

- Each student will be required to meet in their designated area upon arrival at Grassfield.
- In order for the check-in process to go smoothly, we need for each student to make the following items available by packing them at the top of their luggage:
 - Concert and Freshman Orchestra Students Concert Attire (Trip Shirt, Khaki's, Red Canvas Shoes
 - Instrument, Folding Stand, Music.....Yes, you will need your own music!
 - All students with medicine need to stop at the nurses table in front of the auditorium to turn in medicines.

Check-In (continued)

Each bus will meet in a specified area:

- BUS 1 (36 passenger Bus) will meet in the CHORUS Room
- Bus 2 (58 passenger bus) will meet in the ORCHESTRA room
- Bus 3 (81 passenger bus) will meet in the AUDITORIUM STAGE area

Check-In (continued)

- In each designated area there will be a group of chaperones assigned with a list of all the students on that bus.
- Chaperones will check that you have everything you need and will send you to your bus when you have been checked in and received your luggage tags.

Spring Trip Behavior Contract

 The following is a list of rules that we expect every student to abide by at all times while they are on this trip. It is imperative that each student and parent understand the rules and the consequences that will follow if the rules are broken.

Students are expected to conduct themselves
with class and maturity at all times. Chaperones
will be "on duty" at all times to meet students'
needs and to enforce the rules and regulations.
Students knowing of any potential rule
infractions are encouraged to bring them to a
chaperone immediately with the assurance of
anonymity if desired

- Students will be considered in school while participating on this trip. ALL school rules and District rules will apply during the dates of the trip.
- Students will be expected to follow the specified requirements as outlined in the school handbook.
- Students will be required to sign the Spring Trip Behavior Contract before they depart for Orlando.

- The regular school dress code will be strictly enforced. Students are expected to dress in a manner which will represent the school appropriately.
- The use of ANY alcoholic beverages, drug substances, or any type of tobacco (cigarettes, vape or chew) is NOT permitted. Not even if you are of legal age! Students will be sent home for an infraction of this rule at their parent's expense

- No student may leave their hotel room once curfew has been established. If you need something, call your Chaperone! Any student caught leaving their room will be sent home at their parent's expense.
- Students will be "taped" into their rooms at curfew. If that tape is broken during the night those students will be questioned and will be sent home if a reasonable response is not given.
- Security Officers have been hired for hotel security to enforce curfew and monitor noise levels.

- Students are expected to be at every event during this trip, on time and ready. We will be moving 175 people every time we go somewhere and cannot afford to have people late and ill prepared.
- Students are expected to follow the directions of all appointed chaperones and leaders on this trip at ALL times. Failure to do so repeatedly will result in your child being sent home.

- All bus riding rules will be strictly enforced.
 Please treat our drivers with respect and keep your area of the bus clean
- When in doubt about any rule, students should ask their Chaperone BEFORE they decide to participate in the activity.
- Please understand that your behavior on this trip will directly affect future groups'ability to travel

Suggested Items to Pack

- Chamber Concert Attire
- Concert/Freshman Concert Attire (trip t-shirt, Khaki pants, red canvas shoes)
- Instrument, Music and Folding Stand
- Debit/Credit card for purchases in the Parks (they are cashless)
- Cell phone and charger (portable charger)
- Shorts & t-shirts, jeans, comfortable walking shoes
- Windbreaker or light Jacket & Sun Screen
- Orchestra Prom outfit. Please remember the school dress code. (Try to pack your dress/tuxedo with your roommates to save on luggage space on the coach)

Items to Pack

(continued)

- Blanket for the bus! It will be cold!
- Snacks for the bus ride and for the hotel room
- Playing Cards, PG Movies, Books for the Bus
- \$100 spending money for souvenirs & food (5 meals are not included in this package; 2 breakfasts enroute, 3 meals in the parks)
- Suitcase must be a medium sized one, not a large one, we just don't have room! Each person gets 1 suitcase, 1 carry on and 1-2 garment bags per hotel room for their dress/tuxedo.
