9:00 AM **Group Admission to the Georgia Aquarium**

Georgia Aquarium - a dynamic, ship-shaped building, featuring over 55,000 aquatic animals from over 500 different species. These diverse creatures of the sea will swim through five million gallons of water. The Georgia Aquarium will be divided into five main viewing areas: Cold Water, Fresh Water, The Open Ocean, Coastal and The Georgia Quest (an interactive area for kids of all ages).

Included with admission is the 4D Theater where you will experience the underwater world from an animal's point of view. One of the most advanced theaters in the world, this show features interactive seats and unique special effects that are built into the theater itself.
